As summer approaches and the beautiful weather draws us away from home for vacation and time away from work, it is important to remember the Third Commandment.\*

**The Third Commandment:** “Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.”

**Luther’s Explanation in the Small Catechism:** “What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not despise preaching and His Word, but hold it sacred and gladly hear and learn it.”

Often, when we think about remembering the Sabbath day we think about it as a day of rest. Because of this, many of us are tempted to think that means sleeping in and not doing any work, but consider the quotes below.

From Vajta Vilmos, “To [Luther] Sabbath rest means *more* than a pause from work. It should be an opportunity for God to *do His work* on man. God wants to distract man from his daily toil and so open him to God’s gifts. To observe Sabbath... means pausing from all our works and *letting God do His work in us and for us.*” (Emphasis added.)

Author John T. Pless adds this, “The Third Commandment builds a protective fence, as it were, around time so that there is a space to hear God’s Word.”

Observing the Sabbath doesn’t simply mean resting from our work in order to sleep in or go fishing (both of which are wonderful things, by the way). Observing the Sabbath means receiving from God the gifts he has for us and we receive those gifts in worship with other Christians on Sunday morning. What do we receive when we gather to hear God’s Word? Nothing other than the Gospel; the forgiveness of sins, the assurance of our salvation, and the peace that comes with knowing you are right with God through Jesus Christ.

Enjoy your summer, catch some fish, go camping, visit relatives, but don’t neglect the time that God has carved out for you to receive from him.

 Pointed me to my Father above.




