## **The Church Council: Meeting of January 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018**

- Pastor made 2 visits with Holy Communion in December, led the Strasburg Care Center Service on Dec. 3, had 14 Youth to the parsonage for Christmas on the 20<sup>th</sup>, officiated at the Ray Renschler Funeral on the 21<sup>st</sup>, officiated at the Umber/Weber wedding on the 30<sup>th</sup>, officiated at the Arlo Ohlhauser Funeral on January 5<sup>th</sup>, and the Donald Schiermeister Funeral on the 12<sup>th</sup>. Adult confirmation is being planned.
- Board approved Pastor Sean's time off on February 18<sup>th</sup>.
- Parsonage Kitchen Remodel Committee has been established, and the Council is asking for any church members to join the committee and to notify Brenda. A \$25,000 goal for the kitchen remodel was established, and the current balance in the fund is \$10,247.

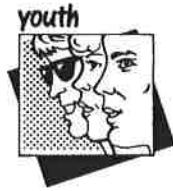

## Peace Lutheran Church February Mission of the Month North Dakota Teen Challenge

North Dakota Teen Challenge for Adults officially opened in June of 2004 in Williston, North Dakota, as an alcohol & drug residential recovery center for men. Within a year it became apparent that the need for this program was growing. In order to meet the increasing demand, NDTC relocated to Mandan, North Dakota, on September 1, 2005. In 2006 NDTC began accepting adult women into the program. Our program currently hosts about fifty adult residents.



North Dakota Teen Challenge offers professional, Christ-centered recovery principles for complete freedom from the bondage of drugs and alcohol problems.

The North Dakota Teen Challenge is a strong advocate for addicts ages 18-80 wanting to achieve a drug-free life. We work with churches and organizations across the state to bring our message of hope and healing, providing a last chance for many people to get the help they desperately need.
