This month we begin something new in our Sunday services. It is called the Narrative Lectionary. Instead of having four Scripture readings each Sunday we will only have two; a longer primary passage and a shorter supplemental passage. From September to the middle of December, the primary (preaching) passage will be from the Old Testament. The passages will work their way narratively through the story of God in human history beginning in Genesis on through to the Prophets. Right around Christmas and on through Easter, the narrative will come exclusively from the Gospel of Matthew.

One of the reasons we made the change was to encourage a better overall view of the overarching story of Scripture which is ultimately about what God has done for us through Jesus Christ. Another reason for the change is for all of us to get better acquainted with reading the Scriptures. The passages for each Sunday will not be printed in our bulletin. Instead, you will be invited to open up a pew Bible or bring your Bible from home and follow along that way. (Parents may want to encourage their children to bring their Bibles the church has given them over the years to worship – they are the same translation as the pew Bibles, after all!)

Lastly, you will find in your bulletin (and in the monthly newsletter) recommended passages to read each day from Sunday to Sunday. These passages are ones that I have chosen to either help fill the gaps in the story from Sunday to Sunday or to help you become more acquainted with certain passages/books in Holy Scripture. Daily readings are, of course, optional, but when one commits to daily study of the Word, I think you'll find that one's faith and understanding of God will increase quite a bit.

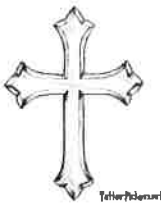
The Celebrate will lead the services on the 7th and 21st (1st and 3rd Sundays). We won't have Communion on those days. The 14th and 28th will have Communion.

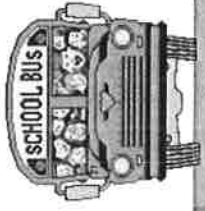

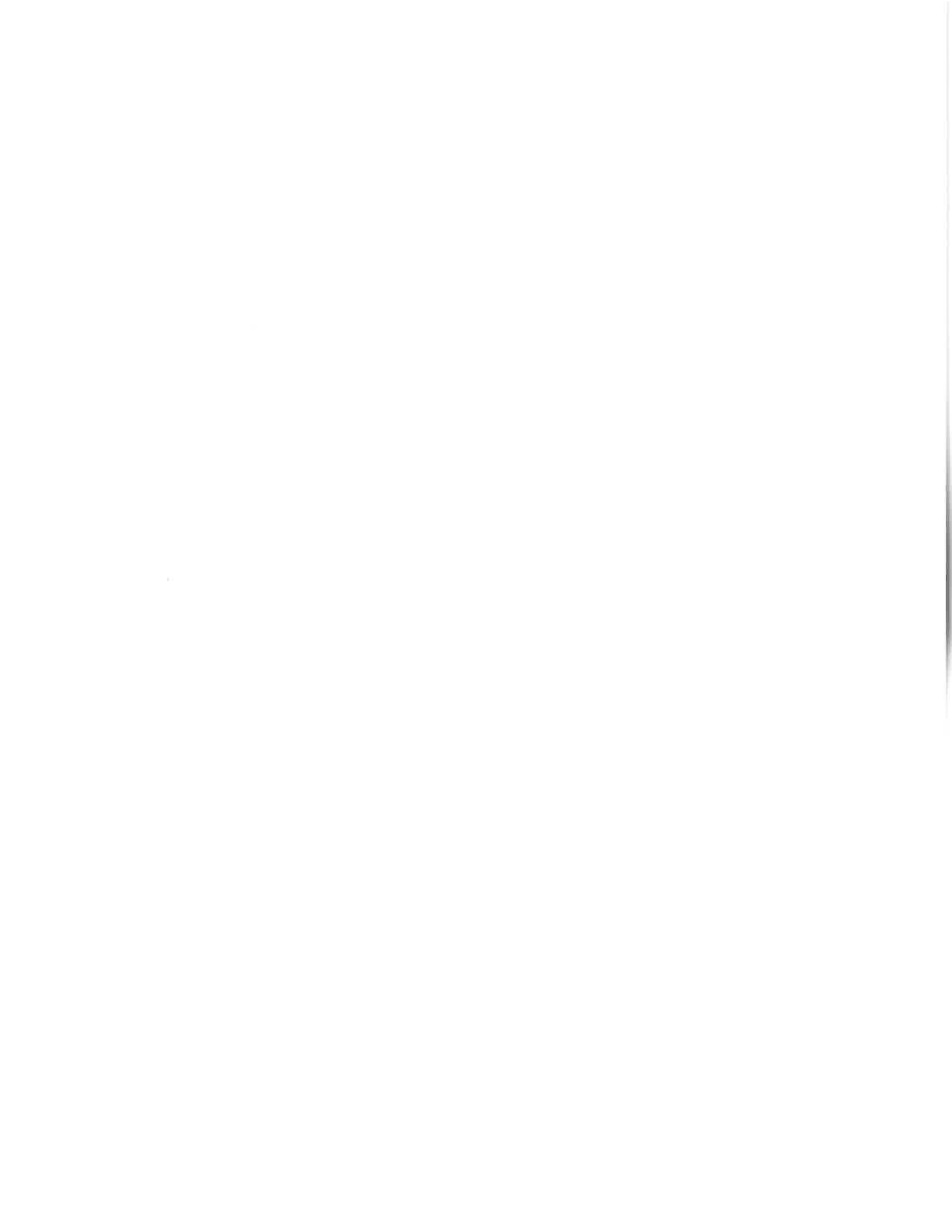
