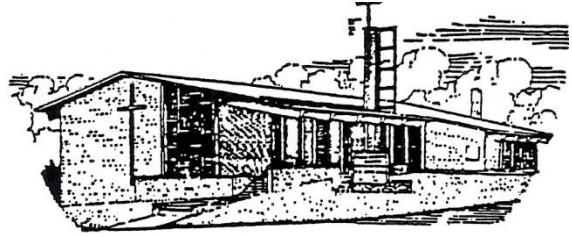

“Stay at Home” Statement: The North Dakota Department of Health recommends that high-risk individuals (elderly and those with underlying conditions) continue viewing services from home. If you are not feeling well, please consider staying home until you have recovered.

Social Distancing: For the sake of social distancing, every other pew will be taped off. We ask that family “pods” sit at least six feet away from other “pods”.

Entering, Exiting from Church, Greeters and Ushers: Our plan is to have door openers at both entrances. For the time being, we will not have greeters and ask that attendees refrain from giving hugs and handshakes. Bulletins will still be used, but they will not be handed out.

Offering: The offering plates will not be passed, instead attendees will have the opportunity to drop their offering in a plate on their way into the Sanctuary or on their way out. For those wishing to give a “noisy offering,” a can will be available for that as well.

Communion: We will resume our schedule of Communion on the first and third Sunday of each month. We will be serving Communion in the aisle and try to adhere to social distancing/safe handling while it is celebrated.

Children’s Sermons: For the time being we will not be having Children’s Sermons.
