What are the labors and heavy burden Christ invites us away from in Matthew 11? My study Bible notes that "Jewish rabbis spoke of the 'yoke of the Law' as glorious obedience to God, which freed one from obligations to the world and gave rest."

But we know from the Gospels and from Paul's writings (and from all the rest of the Scriptures!) that the Law is itself the burden. There is only one who gloriously obeys God – and he is Jesus Christ. The law only ever shows us our failings. It reveals sin to us. To be yoked to the Law is to be dragged to hell. It demands our death, but Christ in his obedience to it took that death for us.

So Christ, who is gentle and lowly in heart, invites you to take his yoke upon yourself. His yoke is his Gospel. To yoke yourself to Christ is to know forgiveness and to be freed from the Law. Luther says, "The yoke that Christ lays upon us is sweet, and His burden is light. When sin has been forgiven and the conscience has been liberated from the burden and the sting of sin, then a Christian can bear everything easily."

The problem is that we have a propensity towards placing ourselves under the yoke of the Law rather than under the yoke of Christ. This is why it is so important as we are confirmed, as we graduate, and as we vacation to not take ourselves away from the Word which calls us away from the yoke of the Law and places us under the freeing yoke of Christ.

Stay under the yoke of Christ. His yoke is easy and his burden is light.

- ▶ Pastor Sean reported: Quote for projector has been accepted, projector is ordered; 19 kids came to Pastor's house for Youth Group Bible Study on 4/28; Parsonage Bathroom is 99% completed; Made 2 visits to Strasburg Care Center, 1 home visit, & 1 hospital visit in April; Officiated at the funeral for Helen Garnaas May 5th; Confirmation Class will finish up for the season with Youth Group at the parsonage on May 19th; Will continue with online Bible Study weekly, and morning devotions M-F @ 8:10 AM; Planning Vacation Bible School; Summer sermons will be on Psalms and Ephesians.
- <u>Property:</u> Small water issue with the parsonage gutters when it rains, solution would be a bigger down spout. Dave Job will be contacted to take care of the problem.
- Worship: Looking at getting some visitor/misc giving envelopes to put in pews; Approved motion to hire Lisa Hendrickson as janitor.

Ministry on the Margins is a volunteer-based ecumenical ministry committed to supporting those who fall through the cracks during times of transition. Every week we offer hospitality and coffee, several meals, a food pantry, prison-to-society support, an ecumenical Christian worship service, and many other ministries. Read below for a few stories exemplifying Ministry on the Margins.



Suzanne is one of many people who was just one paycheck away from being homeless and when a medical emergency hit, that is exactly where she found herself. Over a seven month period she valiantly kept her family of four together. They lived with friends, in a garage, tent and small hotel room. During this time, *Ministry on the Margins* supplied stability, rides to appointments, basic necessities, and connections to available resources. When housing was acquired, *Ministry on the Margins* helped with furniture and moving. The greatest reward is watching them help others as they have been helped.

Marcus grew up in the streets of Chicago spending much of his life in and out of juvenile detention centers. He ended up in the ND State Penitentiary and, at the age of 27, finally decided this was not the life he wanted. After connecting with *Ministry on the Margins*, Marcus set two goals – to get his GED and GOD. While in prison he was baptized and he became the first person in his family to earn a GED/diploma. Now that he's out of prison he has a team of mentors who support him and help him with basic life skills. He can be an inspiration to his


Honor Someone With Chancel Flowers!


