What does it mean to have the word of Christ dwell in us richly? Paul E. Deterding writes in his commentary on Colossians that letting the word of Christ dwell in your richly, "points to a continual presence of the Word. It is not merely to be read, commented on, and the like, but it is to be internalized so that it is continually present."

To have the word of Christ internalized and ever-present first means to simply live in the life-giving promises of God given to us in his Word. The benefits God pours out upon his people are extravagant. He gives us forgiveness of sins, he calls us his sons and daughters, he blesses us with the privilege of calling him Father, he provides to us our daily needs, he comforts us, he guides us, and he names us heirs of eternal life. When we put ourselves in a position to have the word of Christ constantly filling us, (think the children's lyric, "fill my cup and let it overflow,") the benefits of God found in his word saturate us.

But wait, there's more! When we are saturated and filled to overflowing with the word of Christ, not only do we have all the benefits of Christ to sustain us as we walk this earth; the word flows out of us as we live the baptized life. When the word of Christ dwells within us we live compassionately, kindly, and humbly; we live in patience with one another and grant forgiveness as we have been forgiven (Colossians 3:12-13).

This is the power of God's Word. It is formative and creative and life-giving. It is the central thing we gather around as we come to worship together. May the Lord continue to bless us as we gather around his word. May he give us ears to hear and hearts receptive to it. May he fill us so fully that with his word that the world is richly blessed through us. Amen.


CARILLON "SPECIAL" MUSIC


Honor Someone With Chancel Flowers!




