Message from Pastor Sean...

Most weekday mornings I host 8:10 Devotions; a short five-to-ten-minute devotion through Facebook Live. For a while now, I've been working through the Psalms. In fact, by the time you read this article, we should be somewhere around Psalm 130.

The Psalms are the perfect Scriptures for a morning devotion. They have rich language for both God and the human condition. The Psalms wondrously praise God for his steadfast love and faithfulness. They uphold his justice, mercy, kindness, and forgiveness for those who fear the Lord.

Also in the Psalms, the writers are not afraid to speak to God about their affliction and heartache. They aren't afraid to question God or to even call him out when God seems silent or distant. Often the psalmists take it upon themselves to remind God of his own Word, calling on God to remember his covenant and the promises he has made to his people. Neither are the writers afraid to pray against evil and evil doers, calling upon God to act against injustice.

I've learned to appreciate all of this as we've worked through the Psalms in 8:10 Devotions. More than anything, I've grown to appreciate the tone, language, and words God has given his people to use in prayer with him. Often the Psalms are more forceful than I would dare to be or more exuberant than I am capable of being. God has given us through the Psalms, (his own sacred Word), the words to pray for every occasion.

If you've never given the Psalms a good look, give them a try. Let them be your prayers and praises when your own words just won't come.

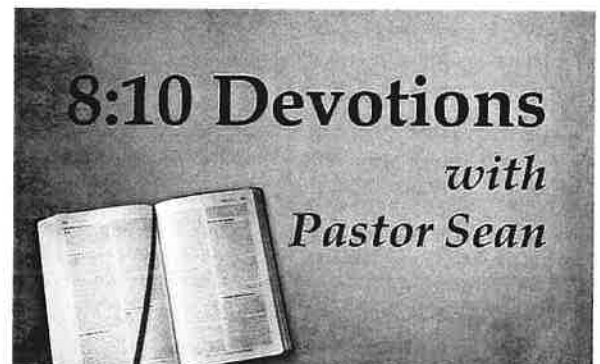

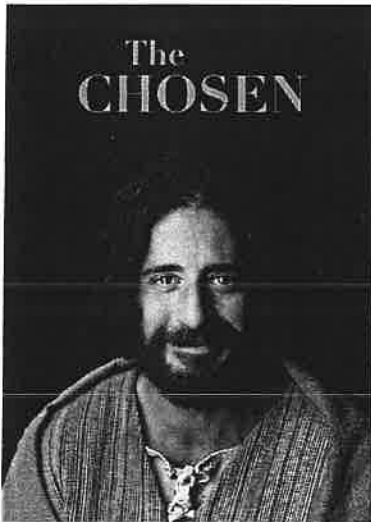

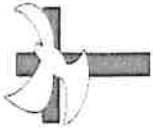
