LCMC is the association of congregations to which our church belongs. LCMC stands for Lutheran Congregations in Mission for Christ and is the church body we joined after leaving the ELCA in 2011. From the LCMC's website:

LCMC is a centrist Lutheran church body, recognizing Scripture as the sole source and norm of faith and life and therefore being a light to, rather than a reflection of, the world.

LCMC is congregationally-based. It recognizes that the congregation, gathered around Word and Sacrament, is the church.

The LCMC doesn't consider itself to be a denomination, rather they are an association where congregations such as ours may maintain autonomy while also enjoying fellowship with other like-minded congregations. As members, we have no obligation to give to the LCMC, but being members of the association means that we adhere to the Lutheran Confessions and to ministry standards set by the LCMC. They don't make statements on social issues unless God's Word "is being consistently challenged." Instead, individual congregations are encouraged to make such statements if they deem it necessary.

While it is possible for a church such as ours to feel alone as a Lutheran congregation by only being members of an association like the LCMC, I appreciate the freedom as long as we stay true to our identity as a Lutheran church in the worldwide body of Christ. If you would like to know more about the LCMC, I encourage you to visit their website, LCMC.net. It would also be a great idea to tune into some of the live-stream from the Annual Gathering held October 2nd-5th.













Mission of the Month
