season of Advent begins in November as well (27th), but it is hard to think of November without thinking of Thanksgiving.

Why is giving thanks so important? Consider this verse from James 1:17, "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change."

James doesn't tell us that *some* gifts come from our Father; they *all* do. Every good and perfect gift has a source and we are not it. Scripture reminds us that all we celebrate and enjoy and appreciate in life comes not from ourselves, but from outside of ourselves. This includes material blessings; house, home, family, food, friends, and security. It also includes heavenly blessings; life, salvation, forgiveness, faith, assurance, and promise. It all comes from our Father in heaven.

Therefore, giving thanks is important because it forces us to acknowledge that these things have been given to us, they are undeserved and graced to us from Someone else. It is cliché this time of year to say that we should give thanks not only at this time of year, but at all times, however the cliché is true. The Lord blesses us at all times so we should be thankful at all times.

And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body. **And be thankful**. And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, **giving thanks** to God the Father through him. **Colossians 3:15-17**


SUNDAY SCHOOL NEWS

From Heavens Helpers' Facebook page:

We at Heavens Helpers are a group of Christians doing what Jesus did by helping the helpless and healing the sick through faith in Jesus. We help the Helpless; pray for the weak, the sick and all who would ask.

The purpose in opening the Soup Cafe was to show the love of Jesus Christ by feeding people both physically and spiritually free of charge... The Soup Cafe is not set up as a typical "soup kitchen" but more like a cafe. We encourage patrons to seat themselves while we serve them by taking their order and bringing them their food. We are set up just like a restaurant only with Christian music or teaching playing on the flat screen TV. We serve at least two homemade soups each day along with two types of sandwiches along with dessert and coffee. Patrons are allowed to eat as much as they want; as long as they do not waste the food we will continue serving them. Our customer base includes the homeless on the street, homeless living in their cars, individuals on disability, working poor, elderly, and those in need who just want a homemade bowl of soup.

Everything at the Soup Cafe is given to people free of charge including bread, desserts, Bibles and books which people can take home.




Emmons County Ministerial Thanksgiving Baskets


