
In the coming weeks, we'll journey around the Promised Land and hear stories that are very much connected to geography. We'll visit Shechem where God first gave his promise to Abraham and where the people of God made promises (that they later broke) to God.

From there we'll visit Bethel, which means "house of God," but later becomes the location of idols. We'll wade through the Jordan River, the figurative gateway into and out of the Promised Land. We'll also visit Bethlehem, the "house of bread" and be reminded of how Jesus is our bread from heaven.

And then, of course, we'll find our way to Jerusalem, the "way of peace" and the place Christ will finally win our peace. During Holy Week, we'll visit specific places in Jerusalem as well, the Upper Room, Mt. Calvary, and lastly the Empty Tomb.

I hope you to see you during Lent. It is such a special and important time of the Church year.

The Church Council, Meeting of February 8th

- Pastor's Report: SCC Service on Jan. 12; Youth Group Jan. 18 with 14 or 15 students attending; ECMA meeting on Jan. 19; 2 visits in Jan., 1 with Holy Communion; Preparing for Lent and starting to plan VBS curriculum.
- Property: A handicap rail was installed in the Pastor's office bathroom. The legs of the unsteady table in the narthex were repaired and will be attached to the table. An example of a piece to place on the bathroom light switches was looked at to solve the problem of the fan being left on many times. The light & fan will get turned off at the same time.
- > Stewardship: Endowment balance as of 2/7 is \$58,696.08. Plan is to have a Thrivent rep here to speak with the congregation briefly about different programs they have.
- Worship: Jacqueline Wald transferred her membership to United Lutheran in Langdon, ND. Terry, Corinna, and Isaac Huber transferred to Peace Lutheran from Good Shepherd Lutheran Church in Burnsville, MN. Discussed dividing families up in church for serving as ushers, greeters, readers, acolytes; one group for each month.
- Evangelism: Planning to do a women's Bible Study on Ruth possibly late spring/early summer.
- Old Business: Pastor received his beef.
- New Business: Council will serve Lent Supper on March 8. Council will meet on March 8 after Lent Service. Reminder: Per the School's Lockdown Protocol, the Church is a "flight" location. Philosophy is Hide, Flee, Fight. High School and part of Middle School would flee to our church, elementary to the library.


Easter Lilies...


Lent Food Drive

As we all know, the cost of food and basic toiletries have been getting more and more expensive. It has impacted all our budgets, but especially those who are on low and fixed incomes. This year during Lent we will be have a drive for our local food pantry.

Non-perishable items of all kinds are welcome: canned vegetables, fruits, and soups; dry good like noodles; peanut butter and jelly; and canned tuna and chicken are all appreciated. Also needed are products like deodorant, toilet paper, shampoo, toothpaste and toothbrushes, body wash and soap. When Lent begins, a table will be set-up in the Narthex to receive these items.



If you or someone you know needs access to food from the pantry, it is open each Wednesday from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM and the 2^{nd} and 4^{th} Mondays of the month from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM.


We received \$281 from Thrivent Choice \$ since the 1st of January.

Looking ahead to April, the kids will sing in church on April 2nd, which is Palm Sunday.






Confirmation and Youth Group Schedule No meeting in March
