### Message from Pastor Sean...

Recently, the preaching passage in our Narrative Lectionary was from Acts 10. In this passage, Peter is called to go to the family of Cornelius, a devout Gentile, and preach the good news of Jesus Christ.

I appreciate the simplicity of Peter's message. He doesn't go into a long diatribe

explaining the Scriptures from Genesis to the present time. Nor does he come down hard on Cornelius and his family. He gives them the simple facts.

"God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power. He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him. And we are witnesses of all that he did both in the country of the Jews and in Jerusalem. They put him to death by hanging him on a tree, but God raised him on the third day and made him to appear, not to all the people but to us who had been chosen by God as witnesses, who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead. And he commanded us to preach to the people and to testify that he is the one appointed by God to be judge of the living and the dead. To him all the prophets bear witness that everyone who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins through his name." (Acts 10:38-43)

Notice the key points: God anointed Jesus; Jesus did good and healed all oppressed by the devil, He died on the cross (tree), was raised on the third day, and everyone who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins. That is the core message of the Gospel.

At the end of Matthew's Gospel, we are all commanded by Christ to "go and make disciples of all nations." But sometimes that command can feel very daunting. What do we say? How do we make disciples?

Do as Peter did. Know the simple facts and give the simple facts. Jesus suffered, died, was buried, and raised to life for you for the forgiveness of sins. It really is as simple as that. It is the good news for you and good news for all.

Our current company does not deal with this size elevator anymore. \*Mowing will reach out to Justin to see if he would like to continue doing it. \*Discussed the cemetery south of town. Will look at the issues when it is warmer out. \*Discussed tarring the parking lot. \*Tabled discussion on Spring Cleaning until next month. \*Basement and Sanctuary floors need to be waxed, and a few tiles are missing. It will be checked into.



### **Tile Refinishing Project**

On Tuesday, April 18<sup>th</sup>, the Church Council had a special meeting to discuss taking care of the basement floors. It was decided that the best way forward was to accept a quote from Dakota One Coating to cover the tile in the entire basement with an epoxy fully chipped floor coating. Many use this type of covering to cover over and seal their cement in basement or garage floors. This would be a cost effective and safe way to cover tile in our church building that is dated, brittle, breaking, and in need of yearly care. At the time of this writing, discussion was still being had on covering the tile in the Sanctuary as well. Members are invited to give directly to this project as they see fit.


In April, we have taken in \$538 at this writing for our "Mission of the Month" "The God's Child Project."
