the Servant in Isaiah is. Some argue the Servant is the prophet Isaiah himself, others say the Servant is God's people, Israel. As Christians, we believe Jesus the Messiah fulfills the prophet's words about the Servant.

During our Wednesday evening services Lent (which begins February 14th), we'll take a close look at the four Servant Songs of Isaiah. As we read and contemplate those passages together, we will see how, in Christ, the Lord promises justice for the broken and needy. We will also see how Christ fulfills God's desire for Israel; he is the Servant she should have been. We will see that Jesus is God's suffering and perfectly obedient Servant who will undergo the most severe oppression for the sake of sinners.

The four Servant Songs of Isaiah are beautifully written pieces of poetry and they point us firmly towards Jesus as we journey through Lent to the cross and witness the suffering of the Servant for ourselves. I hope you will take the time to slow down during Lent not only to attend worship on Wednesday evenings, but to eat together with your church family prior to our services.

- ▶ Pastor Sean reported: Finished pre-marital counseling for one couple (wedding not scheduled), Christmas Caroling/Movie December 10, Perishable Food Distribution December 13, Caregiver's Connections December 14, 1 hospital visit & 1 Nursing Home visit, Coming up: Lent begins February 14, and contemplating taking youth to Des Moines for LCMC Youth Gathering (July 7 12)
- ➢ Property Report: *Concerns about the stairs blending into each other. Will check into different types of stripping for the edges of steps. * A congregation member took some pews, shortened them, and has donated the shortened pews back. One 48" and one 42", and two 30". Will decide what to do with them. *Loren Hendrickson stated he will take care of the flashing on the post outside. *Still have not heard anything from Tony Sorrels regarding the downspouts. Will look into other contractors if necessary closer to spring.

- ➤ Worship: None
- Education: Sunday School resumed January 7
- > Evangelism: Hot cocoa bar went really well with lots of positive feedback.
- Old Business: None
- New Business: *Discussed possible Church Council members for upcoming term. *An interview was had with an applicant for the Secretary/Bookkeeper position. A motion was made and seconded to offer the Secretary position to Terri Fieldsend. Unanimously approved, Motion carried. *Discussion was held on payment policies for weddings and funerals for members and nonmembers to help cover the extra costs of Janitorial work. Decided for now to mention to the families that a donation would be

- appreciated to cover the extra costs. *Endowment Committee member Joyce Lemer's term is up this year. Per the Chairperson of the Endowment Committee, she is able to do another term. Will bring up at the annual meeting.
- ➤ 2024 Budget was completed. *A motion was made, approved, and carried to increase custodian wage to \$23/hour. *A motion was made, approved, and carried to increase Pastor's salary 1.5%. *Motion was made, approved, and carried to approve the 2024 Budget at \$154,639.



Give using Tithe.ly




