September also marks the beginning of our Narrative Lectionary. As has been the case for the last few years, we'll be in the Old Testament from September 8th through November on Sunday mornings. Beginning in December we'll switch to the Gospel of Luke and stay there through Easter. The Narrative Lectionary is designed to help Sunday morning worshipers get a feel for the full narrative arc of the Scriptures. But because there are not enough Sundays to do the Old Testament justice, I'd like to recommend a book to you.

My favorite author, Chad Bird, recently released his book, "Hitchhiking with the Prophets: A Ride Through the Salvation Story of the Old Testament". Bird's book is a broad survey of the most important figures and moments in the Old Testament. But it is more than that. As the subtitle suggests, Bird highlights how the whole Old Testament story points the reader towards Jesus and the salvation he wins for humanity.

It isn't a long book, only 165 pages, so Bird's survey of the Old Testament isn't exhaustive. This is what makes it a great tool for one who perhaps doesn't know the OT very well and would benefit from an easy-to-read survey before diving in to the Scriptures. It also serves as the perfect summary for those who have read the OT and are very familiar with it. Bird's book gives a great perspective on the familiar stories we know from Sunday School and our own reading, but artfully places them into the salvation story. For the seasoned reader of the OT, this book is a nice companion, much like the notes in a study Bible.

I hope to see you on Sunday mornings. I'm excited for our new year to begin and to look once again at the OT with you. Should you desire to borrow my copy of "Hitchhiking with the Prophets" rather than buy your own, you are welcome to stop by.

A Summary of the Church Council Meeting of August 14, 2024:

The meeting was called to order by Sec. Jennifer Vetter at 7:02 pm.

Council members in attendance: Lori Bechtold, Tim Dockter, Mark Heidrich, Kevin Hendrickson, Erica Hoff-Wald, Stan Naumann, and Jennifer Vetter Council members absent from the meeting: Gunnar Hanson and Elwin Nieuwsma.

Pastor Barnhart opened with devotions.

Sec. Jennifer Vetter called for a review of the July 10, 2024 Regular Church Council Meeting Minutes. A motion was made, seconded and unanimously carried to accept the minutes as presented with no corrections. Vice Pres. Hendrickson called for a review of the July 28, 2024 Special Church Council Meeting Minutes. A motion to accept the minutes as presented with no corrections was made, seconded and unanimously carried.

Vice Pres. Hendrickson called for the Treasurer's Report. A motion was made, seconded, and unanimously carried to accept the Treasurer's Report.

Pastor Barnhart presented his report. He made three visits in July and hosted Caregiver's Connections on July 11, 2024. Caregiver's Connections may not continue beyond October. He's been meeting on Tuesdays with area LCMC pastors, parishioners, and staff to establish a Northern Plains District of the LCMC. He will attend the LCMC Annual Gathering in Marion, Iowa from September 29 - October 2, 2024. The funeral for Edna Serr was held August 5, 2024. He expanded Sunday morning services and 8:10 Devotions live streams to YouTube and Facebook. Coming soon: Confirmation (eight students) begins August 21; Sunday School begins September 8; Adult Bible Study resumes at 9:30 am September 8; Worship moves to 10:45 am September 8; Second graders receive their Bibles September 15; a baptism is planned September 15; Youth Group (7-12th Grade) begins September 18; Harvest Festival is September 22 with worship at 10:00am; and a wedding (Shelby Kelsch and Mark Jochim) on Saturday, September 28, 2024.

Vice Pres. Hendrickson called for the Property Committee report. The asphalt company did not return Mark's calls, messages, or texts for a bid. The Roehrich Construction bill is \$4,306.00. A motion to pay the bill from the Website Donation account was made, seconded and carried unanimously.

Vice Pres. Hendrickson called for the Stewardship Committee report. A CD at Unison Bank (current balance \$20,611.15) matures 8/10/24. A Motion was made, seconded and carried unanimously to renew the CD for six months at 5.05% interest.

Vice Pres. Hendrickson called for the Worship Committee report. No report.

Vice Pres. Hendrickson called for the Education Committee. Jennifer Vetter shared Sunday School scheduling details. Sunday School begins September 8, 2024 with root beer floats following church service. The Christmas Program is scheduled for December 15, 2024.

Vice Pres. Hendrickson called for the Evangelism Committee report. No report.

Vice Pres. Hendrickson called for Old Business. No report.

Vice Pres. Hendrickson called for New Business. Lisa Ptacek and Deb Jahner will lead Harvest Festival planning. Further discussion on Harvest Festival planned for the September meeting.

Hearing no further new business, Vice Pres. Hendrickson called for a motion to adjourn the meeting. A motion was made and seconded and unanimously carried to adjourn.

The meeting was closed with the Lord's Prayer. The meeting adjourned at 7:52pm.


Adult Bible Study/Online Bible Study
