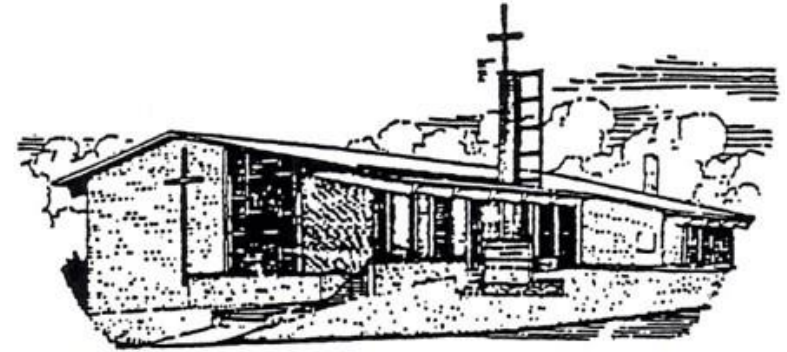
*A graveside service for Maggie Bender will be held on **Tuesday, Oct. 28th** at the Linton Cemetery at **10:00 AM**.
