*A sign-up for our Lent Soup Suppers has been posted on the Narthex Bulletin board. Ash Wednesday falls on February 18th.

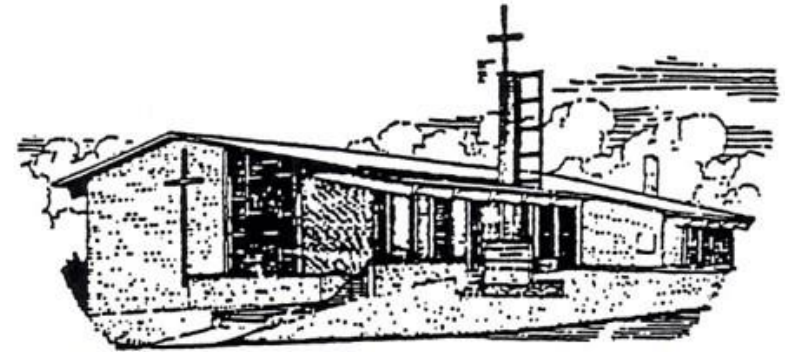
